School Road (B386) Windlesham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 18 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of School Road (B386) Windlesham as extends from its junction with (D6) Poplar Avenue to its junction with (D4) Snows Ride.

Alternative Route – School Road; A30 London Road; Snows Ride; and School Road.

The Order is required to allow sewer cover replacement and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Cappagh Contractors within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30 am and 3.30 pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 26 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. The emergency services and all other traffic will be required to follow the diversion route.
