Staines By-Pass (A308) Ashford / Staines-Upon-Thames
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 26 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Staines By-Pass (A308) Ashford / Staines-Upon-Thames as extends from its junction at the roundabout known as the “Crooked Billet Roundabout” to its junction at the roundabout known as the “Fordbridge Roundabout”.
Alternative Route – Fordbridge Road; Church Road; Stanwell Road; and A30 London Road or this same route in reverse.
- (b) suspend “The Borough of Spelthorne (Fordbridge Road, Ashford) (Prohibition of Heavy Commercial Vehicles) Order 1996” in its entirety.

This Order, which will commence on 31 January 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: bridge deck repair and/or bridge maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be completed as night-time and weekend closures.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspension will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works and for reasons of safety there will be no access through the works area when the closures are in effect, all traffic will be required to use the diversion route listed above. No sole access will be affected.
