Station Road (B2032) Betchworth
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 02 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Road (B2032) Betchworth as extends from its junction with (X68610) The Quarry northwards for approximately 40 metres.

Alternative Routes – Northbound Station Road; A25 Reigate Road/Buckland Road/West Street/London Road; A217 London Road/Reigate Hill/Brighton Road; Dorking Road; Pebble Hill; and Station Road; Southbound: Station Road; Pebble Hill; Dorking Road; A217 Brighton Road/Reigate Hill/London Road; A25 Castlefield Road/Church Street/High Street/West Street/Buckland Road/Reigate Road; and Station Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms poletest works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 10 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via operatives on site, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
