Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2022

On 02 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth as extends from its junction with (A248) Dorking Road to its junction with (X7273) Blackheath; and
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in so far as it affects that length of road described in part (a); and
- (c) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Sample Oak Lane (D216) Chilworth Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022” in so far as it affects that length of road described in part (a).

Alternative Route – A248 Dorking Road/New Road; Wonersh Common; Blackheath Lane; and Sample Oak Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow new telecoms fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 9.30am and 4.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 14 March 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
