

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**Croft Road (D5427) Godalming**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 30 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Croft Road (D5427) Godalming as extends from its junction with (D5427) South Street to its junction with (D5427) Latimer Road.

Alternative Route – Croft Road; Brighton Road; A3100 Flambard Way; Holloway Hill; and Croft Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to allow telecoms pole testing works and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 4pm within the 12-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 05 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
