Thorpe Road (B3376) Staines Upon Thames
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 04 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Thorpe Road (B3376) Staines Upon Thames that is crossed by the Thorpe Road Level Crossing and for a distance of 20 metres either side.

Alternative Route – Thorpe Road; A308 The Causeway/The Glanty; The Avenue; High Street; Vicarage Road; and Thorpe Lea Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate barrier maintenance and/or general maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 11.30pm and 5.30am within the 18-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 11 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will operate only when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained when safe to do so by operatives on site.
