The Surrey County Council
White Rose Lane (D3708) and Heathside Crescent (D3708) Woking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 11 May 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of

(a) White Rose Lane (D3708) Woking as extends from its junction with (D3709) Heathside Road to its junction with (D3708) Heathside Crescent. Alternative Route - White Rose Lane; Hill View Road; A320 Guildford Road/Victoria Road; D3708 Victoria Road; Station Approach; Oriental Road; and Heathside Crescent; and

(b) Heathside Crescent (D3708) Woking as extends from its junction with (D3708) White Rose Lane westwards for a distance of approximately 10 metres.

Alternative Route - Heathside Crescent: Station Approach: and Heathside Road.

The Order is required to facilitate underground telecoms utility works and/or underground telecoms maintenance works and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 night between the hours of 9pm and 6am within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 17 May 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained via operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
