D2279 Manor Drive, Ewell
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 19 October 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D2279 Manor Drive, Ewell that extends from its junction with D2346 Preston Drive, to the south-western property boundary of "No.42 Manor Drive".

This Traffic Order is required to enable Surrey County Council to carry out surface dressing and/or resurfacing and/or improvement and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within 7 days of the 18 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 01 November 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency services, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for residents and businesses will be maintained via the vehicular diversion route: - D2286 Meadow Walk, D2207 Highfield Drive, D2041 Bradford Drive and D2346 Preston Drive.

In the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time under Section 3 of the Act, the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24-hour period. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to a suitable location outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.
