D5302 High Street, Rowledge – Farnham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of D5302 High Street, Rowledge - Farnham. This Traffic Order is required to enable BT Openreach to carry out piling and/or cabling and/or ducting and/or maintenance works in the length of D5302 High Street, Rowledge - Farnham that extends from the north-eastern property boundary of "No.7 High Street, Rowledge" southwards for 50m. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 4pm, within 1 day of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 07 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Alternative route: - Rowledge High Street, Manley Bridge Road, Chapel Road, The Avenue and Fullers Road.
