Eashing Lane (D94) Milford
Temporary Traffic Management Order 2023

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to

(1) prohibit any person from entering or proceeding on foot or by any other means in that length of the footway adjacent to the northwest bound carriageway of Eashing Lane (D94) Milford as extends from its junction with (D5425) Quarry Hill and (D5424) Ockford Drive

There are no alternative routes for this closure.

(2) prohibit waiting, loading, and unloading at any time by vehicles on both sides of the carriageway in that length of Eashing Lane (D94) Milford as extends from its junction with (D5425) Quarry Hill and (D5424) Ockford Drive

This Order is required to enable telecoms connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Open Reach within the length of roads described in this notice.

These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 1.20pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Order which commences on 23 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure and waiting restrictions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed

Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times via operatives on site.
