C18 White Lane, Ash
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 01 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and (7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to: - 1. Prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of C18 White Lane, Ash that extends from its junction with D66 Ash Green Road and C18 Foreman Road, to its junction with C19 Poyle Road. 2. Suspend "Surrey County Council White Lane (C18) Ash Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" in its entirety. This Traffic Order is required to enable Walker Construction (UK) Limited to carry out traffic signals installations on bridge and/or footpath works and/or carriageway resurfacing and/or maintenance works. These works are anticipated to be carried out within 9 weeks of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 06 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated will be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services, residents, businesses, pedestrians and, dismounted cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times. Alternative route: - White Lane, Poyle Road, The Street, Manor Road, Ash Street, Grange Road, Foreman Road and White Lane.
