

**TANDRIDGE - 2015 ALLOCATION OF RECEPTION SCHOOL PLACES IN THE BOROUGH OF TANDRIDGE FOR SEPTEMBER 2016**

The data in this document sets out the reception allocation figures for the majority of Surrey's schools in the borough of Tandridge as of 18 April 2016. In some cases vacancies remained after the initial allocation to on time applicants and these were filled by applicants who had applied late. Where no measurement is shown, all applicants who applied on time were offered a place. In all other cases measurements relate to the last criterion for which places were offered. All distances quoted are in kilometres. **KEY: PAN** = Published Admission Number; **SEN/EHCP** = Children with a Statement of Special Educational Needs or an Education, Health and Care Plan ; **LAC & PLAC** = Looked After Children and Previously Looked After Children; \* = Schools intending to drop back to PAN ; # = School intending to admit an exceeded PAN of: Marden Lodge Primary School - 60.
