**Horsham Road (A281) Grafham**  
**(Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2021**

On 30 June 2021 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and (7) and 15(8)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be that no person shall drive any motor vehicle in that length of Horsham Road (A281) Grafham as extends from its junction with Run Common Road to its junction with Selhurst Common Road, at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour. This Order will extend the existing Surrey County Council Horsham Road (A281) Grafham Temporary 30 mph Speed Limit Notice 2021, and is required because of the likelihood of danger to the public, in the length of road described above and will commence on 3 July 2021 for a period of 12 months. The temporary restriction will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed and will continue at all times whilst remedial carriageway works are being executed, which is anticipated to be for a further 4 weeks, during which time that part of The Surrey County Council (Various Roads in Bramley and Cranleigh in the Borough of Waverley) (30mph 40mph and 50mph Speed Limit) Order 2009 will be suspended in so far as it applies to the length of road specified in this Notice. No speed limit imposed by this Notice applies to vehicles falling within Regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with Regulation 3(4) of those Regulations.
