Parkers Lane (D2631) Ashtead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 28 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Parkers Lane (D2631) Ashtead as extends from a point in line with the south western boundary of No.9 Parkers Lane to a point in line with the south western boundary of No.5 Parkers Lane. The alternative route will be Parkers Lane; Rectory Lane; A24 The Street / Leatherhead Road; and Parkers Hill or this same route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate –

- (a) new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UKPN within the length of road described in this notice. Works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 6pm commencing 09 August 2021; and
- (b) new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water within the length of road described in this notice. Works are anticipated to be carried out over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm commencing 06 September 2021.

These works are anticipated to be completed within 5 weeks of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 09 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents and businesses within the closure area, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
