Rusham Road (D3185) Egham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 18 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Rusham Road (D3185) Egham as extends from a point in line with the north eastern boundary of No.61 Rusham Road, also known as “Homelea” to a point in line with the south western boundary of No.58 Rusham Road.

Alternative Route – Rusham Road; North Street; Grange Road; Church Road; Station Road; and Rusham Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate water utility works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 24 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
