Steep Hill (D36) Chobham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 21 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Steep Hill (D36) Chobham as extends from its junction with the north western access to the property known as “Home Farm” to a point approximately 90 metres east south east along (D36) Steep Hill.

The alternative route will be via Steep Hill; Windsor Road; Windlesham Road; Woodcock Lane; and Steep Hill or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 6pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 03 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents within the closure area, the emergency services, pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times.
