Church Lane (D1421) Chaldon
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 11 August 2021 Surrey County Council Propose to Make the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Church Lane (D1421) Chaldon as extends from a point in line with the northern boundary of the property known as “The Rookery” to a point in line with the northern boundary of the property known as “Wayside”.
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Church Lane (D1421), Caterham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2020” in its entirety; and
- (c) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Church Lane (D1421), Caterham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order No. 2 2020” in its entirety.

Alternative Route – Church Lane; Doctors Lane; Rook Lane; and Church Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole testing works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 August 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via operatives on site, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
