Rushett Common (C36) Bramley and Run Common (C36) Shamley Green
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 25 August 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in –

- (a) that length of Rushett Common (C36) Bramley as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as “Rushett Farm Cottage” to its junction with Run Common (C36) Shamley Green.
- (b) that length of Run Common (C36) Shamley Green as extends from its junction with Rushett Common (C36) Bramley to its junction with the access to the properties known as “White House” and “Run Common Cottage”.

Alternative Route – (B2128) Guildford Road, (B210) Elmbridge Road and (A281) Horsham Road or this route in reverse or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 12 August 2021 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: carriageway repair and/or embankment repair works.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Due to the nature of the works and to avoid danger to persons or traffic using the road and to prevent the likelihood of any such danger arising there will be no access through the closure area. No access to property is affected by this closure area. All traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
