Various Roads in Stoke D'Abernon
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 20 October 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in –

- (a) that length of Woodlands Lane (A245) Stoke D'Abernon as extends from its junction with the access to the property known as "Bruces Doggy Daycare" to its junction with A245 Stoke Road and D2508 Cobham Road; and
- (b) that length of Stoke Road (A245) Stoke D'Abernon as extends from its junction with A245 Stoke Road and D2508 Cobham Road to its junction with the access to the property known as "Squires Garden Centre".

Alternative Route – A245 Woodlands Lane / Woodlands Road; Oaklawn Road; A244 Oxshott Road / Leatherhead Road / High Street / Warren Lane / Copsem Lane; A3 Esher By-Pass; A307 Portsmouth Road; and A245 Between Street / High Street / Mill Road / Stoke Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of UK Power Networks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out in two stages over 5 days within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 October 2021.

The works for part (a) are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm within 2 days commencing 25 October 2021. The works for part (b) are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 6pm within 3 days commencing 27 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic including emergency service vehicles will be required to use the signed diversion route.
