Carhouse Lane (D6325) Horsell
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.3) 2021

On 03 November 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Carhouse Lane (D6325) Horsell as extends from its junction at the roundabout with (C12) Littlewick Road; (C140) Horsell Birch; and (D7296) Kestrel Way to a point approximately 75 metres north eastwards along (D6325) Carhouse Lane.

Alternative Route – Littlewick Road; Barrs Lane; Chobham Road; and Carhouse Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate access to underground telecoms structures to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 nights between the hours of 9pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 02 November 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
