Parkers Lane (D2631) Ashtead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order (No.2) 2021

On 01 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Parkers Lane (D2631) Ashtead as extends from its junction with (D2631) Parkers Hill to its junction with (D2512) Rectory Lane.

The alternative route will be Parkers Hill; A24 Leatherhead Road / The Street; and Rectory Lane; and or this same route in reverse; and

- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council Parkers Lane (D2631) Ashtead Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” in its entirety.

The Order is required to facilitate foul sewer connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Kenward Groundworks within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 weeks between the hours 7.30am and 5pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 06 December 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures, which are anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents and businesses within the closure area, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
