Puttenham Road (C20) Seale
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 15 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Puttenham Road (C20) Seale as extends from its junction with (C21) Elstead Road to its junction with (D85) Totford Lane.

Alternative Route - Elstead Road; Hogs Back; The Street; A31 Runfold Diversion/Hogs Back; Puttenham Hill; The Street; and Seale Lane.

The Order is required to facilitate new overhead fibre cabling works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 22 December 2021. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All through traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
