Longcross Road (B386) Chertsey
Temporary Speed Limit Order 2021

On 22 December 2021 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to impose a temporary speed limit of 40 miles per hour in that length of Longcross Road (B386) Chertsey which extends from its western junction with (D3017) Kitsmeade Lane and its junction with (D3045) Accommodation Road.

The Order is required to safely allow new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Affinity Water within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 8am and 5 pm within the 12 month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 17 January 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary speed limit, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. The speed limit imposed by this Order shall not apply to vehicles used by special forces in accordance with the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011.
