**The Surrey County Council**  
**Station Lane (C32) Enton**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 09 February 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Station Lane (C32) Enton that is crossed by the level crossing known as “Milford Level Crossing” and for a distance of 20 meters on either side.

Alternative Route – Station Lane; A286 Church Road / Petworth Road; Lane End; Malthouse Lane; Hambledon Road; and Station Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate railway drainage and/or railway construction and/or railway maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days within the 18-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 18 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for the emergency services will be via the diversion route.
