The Surrey County Council
By-Pass Road (A24) Leatherhead
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 23 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of By-Pass Road (A24) Leatherhead as extends from its junction at the "Beaverbrook Roundabout" to its junction at the "Givons Grove Roundabout".

Alternative Route – Dorking Road; Church Street; The Crescent; Knoll Roundabout; and A24 By-Pass Road.

This Order, which will commence on 01 April 2022 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: surface dressing and/or major highway maintenance works.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed; and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Any vehicle found to be obstructing the highway during these works will be removed to outside the limits of the works after all reasonable methods have been undertaken to identify and contact the vehicle's owner.

Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route.
