**Dwelly Lane (C85) Edenbridge**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 20 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Dwelly Lane (C85) Edenbridge as extends from its junction with (C87) Haxted Road to its junction with Public Footpath No.221 Limpsfield.

Alternative Route – Haxted Road; Lingfield Road; Crouch House Road; Little Browns Lane; Honeypot Lane; and Dwelly Lane or this same route in reverse. Pedestrians to utilise Public Footpath No.372 Dormansland.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains electrical connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of The independent Connection Provider and/or UKPN within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 week between the hours of 8am and 4pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 25 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected lengths of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists
