**B2234 Merrow Lane, Merrow – Guildford**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 23 November 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of B2234 Merrow Lane, Merrow - Guildford that extends from its junction with B2234 New Inn Lane, to the northern side of its junction with Merrow Lane access to Merrow Sidings.

This Traffic Order is required by Renteq Highways/Dyer and Butler to enable brickwork repairs and/or improvement and/or maintenance works to the “Merrow Common Railway Bridge”. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 10pm and 6am within 2 nights of the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 05 December 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

No sole access to any property will be affected. Access for emergency services, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times. The vehicular diversion route will be via New Inn Lane, London Road, Boxgrove Road, Epsom Road, Park Lane, and Merrow Lane.
