Town End Street (D5427) Godalming
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Town End Street (D5427) Godalming which extends from its junction with Croft Road to its junction with Town End Close. **Alternative Routes** – a) One Way- Town End Street, Brighton Road and Croft Road. b) Traffic from Carlos Street- Carlos Street, Latimer Road and Croft Road. This Order is required to facilitate footway resurfacing works by or on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be completed over 6 days between the hours of 7am and 5pm within 18 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 06 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period
