High Street (A308), South Street (A308),
and Mustard Mill (D6362) Road Staines upon Thames
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of: a) High Street (A308) Staines upon Thames which extends from its junction with (D6362) Mustard Mill Road to its junction with (D3282) Fairfield Avenue; b) South Street (A308) Staines upon Thames which extends from its junction with (D6362) Mustard Mill Road to its junction with the access to Elmsleigh Surface car park; and c) Mustard Mill Road (D3282) Staines upon Thames which extends from its junction with (A308) High Street to its junction with the access to the Premier Inn Hotel car park. Alternative Route- (A308) High Street, (A308) London Road, (A30) Staines Bypass, Heron Lake Road, Wraysbury Road, Bridge Street, (A308) Clarence Street, (A308) Thames Street and (A308) South Street or this route in reverse. This Order, which is anticipated to begin May 2023 for a period of 12 months is required to facilitate highway improvements to widen the footway and resurface the carriageway, works to be completed by or on behalf of Surrey County Council. Works are anticipated to be completed as soon as possible within the 12 month operation of the this Order between the hours of 7pm and 7am. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
