Cranmore Lane (D252) West Horsley
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Cranmore Lane (D252) West Horsley which extends from its junction with (C41) The Street to its junction with (X252) Mount Pleasant. **There is no alternative route for this closure.** This Order is required to facilitate a new gas mains connection works for or on behalf of SGN. These works are anticipated to be completed over 7 days between the hours of 8am and 4pm within 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 13 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for residents, the emergency services, pedestrians, and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times via the use of road-plates on site. All vehicular traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route. In the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time, under Section 3 of the Act, the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24 hour period.
