Chobham Road (A3046) Woking
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Chobham Road (A3046) Woking as extends from its junction with (D3652) Broom Hall Lane to its junction with (D3652) Broom Hall Road. Alternative Route- (A3046) Chobham Road, (A320) Victoria Way, (A320) Chertsey Road, Six Crossroads Roundabout, (A245) Shores Road, (A3046) Kettlewell Hill and (A3046) Chobham Road or this route in reverse. This Order is required to facilitate road crossing electrical connection works by or on behalf of ALS Civil Engineers Ltd. These works are anticipated to be completed within 3 days between 8am and 6pm during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 20 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for emergency services, residents and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
