Barford Lane (D127) Churt
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 1 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Barford Lane (D127) Churt as extends from its junction with (A287) Crossways and (D127) Hale house Lane south-westwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

Alternative Route – (D127) Barford Lane, (A287) Churt Road, (A287) Tilford Road, (A333) Portsmouth Road, (B3002) Headley Road, (B3002) Grayshott Road, Glayshers Hill, Churt Road and (D127) Barford Lane or this route in reverse.

This Order is required to facilitate new gas mains connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SGN. These works are anticipated to be completed over 5 days between the hours of 8am and 4pm within 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 13 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for residents will be maintained at all times. Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to maintain access through the closure for emergency services and all vehicular traffic will be required to use the signed diversion route.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above, or accessible only therefrom, may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
