

ALLOCATION OF RECEPTION SCHOOL PLACES IN THE BOROUGH OF MOLE VALLEY FOR SEPTEMBER 2018

The data in this document sets out the reception allocation figures for Surrey's schools in the borough of Mole Valley as of 16 April 2018. In some cases vacancies remained after the initial allocation to on time applicants and these were filled by applicants who had applied late. Where no measurement is shown, all applicants who applied on time were offered a place. In all other cases measurements relate to the last criterion for which places were offered. All distances quoted are in kilometres.
KEY: PAN = Published Admission Number; **EHCP** = Children with an Education, Health and Care Plan; **LAC & PLAC** = Looked After Children and Previously Looked After Children; **##** = Scott-Broadwood intending to maintain a PAN of 30.
