**The Surrey County Council**  
**Arran Way (D6901) Esher**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

On 21 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Arran Way (D6901) Esher.

There is no applicable alternative route, however access will be maintained via road ramps and/or pathboards.

The Order is required to facilitate new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 10 days within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 July 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for the pedestrians, and cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents, businesses, and the emergency services will be maintained via road ramps and/or pathboards when it is safe to do so. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
