Succombs Hill (D1390) Warlingham
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 08 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Succombs Hill (D1390) Warlingham as extends from its junction with (D1390) Southview Road to its junction with (D1357) Landscape Road.

Alternative Route – Succombs Hill; A22 Wapses Lodge Roundabout; Woldingham Road; Bug Hill; Leas Road; Redvers Road; Westhall Road; Narrow Lane; and Succombs Hill.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms utility repair and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 9.30am and 3pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 21 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists.
