Heath House Road (D3680) Brookwood
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 15 September 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to –

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Heath House Road (D3680) Brookwood as extends from its junction with (D3680) Blackhorse Road to its junction with (X3580) Access to Worplesdon Golf Course from Heath House Road.
- (b) Suspend “The Surrey County Council D3680 Blackhorse Road, D3680 Saunders Lane and D3680 Heath House Road, Brookwood – Woking Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021” insofar as it affects the roads described in parts (a) of this Notice.

Alternative Route – A322 Bagshot Road; Berry Lane; and Blackhorse Road.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms fibre cable installation works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 8am and 4pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 23 September 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closures and suspensions will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times via operatives on site, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.
