

**Notice**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 – Section 14 (1)**  
**Extension to the Surrey County Council Lower Road (D265) Bookham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021**

The Surrey County Council Lower Road (D265) Bookham Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021, which was made on the grounds that works were being or proposed to be executed on, or near, the above mentioned roads and came into operation on 11 February 2021 was due to expire on 10 February 2022, has been extended by Surrey County Council until 10 September 2022. The effect of the order is to

- (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lower Road (D265) Bookham as extends from its junction with (D265) Glebe Close to its junction with (D2536) Church Street and (D2536) High Street; and
- (b) suspend “The County Council of Surrey (Various Roads, Effingham) (Weight Restriction) Order 1983” insofar as it affects The Street (C43) Effingham.

The Order is required to allow gas main replacement works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Southern Gas Networks within the length of road described in this notice.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for Pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access for residents will be maintained only for those with driveways within the closure. Access for the emergency services will be maintained only for emergencies within the closure area. All other traffic will be required to follow the signed diversion route.

Alternative Route - Lower Road; Cobham Road; Guildford Road (Hawks Hill); A246 Guildford Road / Leatherhead Road / Guildford Road; The Street; and Lower Road or this same route in reverse. In the event that it is necessary to restrict any access at any time, under Section 3 of The Act, the road can only be closed for a maximum of 8 hours in any 24 hour period
