Wasp Green Lane (D378) Outwood
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 06 October Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Wasp Green Lane (D378) Outwood as extends from its junction with (D376) Millers Lane to a point in line with the northern boundary of the property known as “Wasp Green Farm”.

Alternative Route – Millers Lane; Brickfield Road; and Wasp Green Lane or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate arboriculture and vegetation clearance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Acones Limited and TreSmith Ltd within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9am and 4pm within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 14 October 2021.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Vehicular access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained by the crew as and when it is required.
