

**Notice**  
**The Surrey County Council**  
**London Road North (A23) Merstham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 26 January 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of London Road North (A23) Merstham as extends from its junction with the A23 Trunk Road and M23 Slip Road to its junction with (D1158) Harps Oak Lane.

Alternative Routes –

- (a) Non-Motorway Users – A23 London Road North (Northbound); A22 Godstone Road; A22 Caterham ByPass; A25 Oxted Road/High Street/Bletchingley Road/Godstone Road/High Street/Castle Street/Bletchingley Road/High Street/Nutfield Road/Redstone Hill; and A23 Princess Way/London Road/London Road South/London Road North; and
- (b) Motorway Users - M23; M25 (Westbound); A217 Reigate Hill; A25 Castlefield Road; A242 Croydon Road/Gatton Park Road; and A23 London Road South/London Road North.

The Order is required to facilitate bridge inspection and /or assessment and/or maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Connect Plus Services within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 2 weeks between the hours of 9pm and 6am within the 12 month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 07 February 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained at all times.
