**Gadbridge Lane (D276) Ewhurst**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022**

On 02 March 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Gadbridge Lane (D276) Ewhurst as extends from

- (a) its junction with (X726) Access to the Paddock to its junction with Public Footpath No.438 Ewhurst; and
- (b) a point in line with the common boundary between the properties known as "Chipchase" and "Underoaks" southwards for a distance of approximately 40 metres.

Alternative Route – Gadbridge Lane; The Green; and Cranleigh Road or this same route in reverse.

This Order, which will commence on 15 March 2022 for a period of 12 months is required because works are being, or are proposed to be, executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Morrison Utility Services, including but not limited to: new mains water connection works. The works in part (a) are anticipated to be carried out within 4 days commencing 15 March 2022. The works in part (b) are anticipated to be carried out within 4 days commencing 25 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closures, which are both anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for residents will be maintained as required via road plates on site. The emergency services and all other traffic will be required to use the diversion route.
