Norwood Hill Road (C57) Charlwood
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 13 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Norwood Hill Road (C57) Charlwood as extends from its junction with (D330) Collendean Lane to its junction with (C61) Stan Hill. The Order is required to facilitate –

- (a) new mains water connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of SES Water between its junction with the access to the property known as "Brittleware Farm" and its junction with Public Footpath No.337 Charlwood. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 4 days between the hours of 8am and 5pm commencing 19 April 2022; and
- (b) telecoms fibre connection works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach between its junction (with C61) Stan Hill and its junction with the access to the property known as "Edolphs Farm". These works are anticipated to be carried out over 3 days between the hours of 9.30am and 4pm commencing 23 May 2022.

These works are anticipated to be carried out as soon as possible within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commence on 19 April 2022. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which for part (a) is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

For part (a) access for pedestrians will be maintained at all times. Access for cyclists, and vehicular access for residents and the emergency services will be via the signed diversion route. For part (b) access for residents, the emergency services, cyclists, and pedestrians will be maintained at all times.

The Council are satisfied that, in accordance with Section 3(2)(a) and 3(2)(b) of the Act, vehicular access to and from premises within the length of road above or accessible only therefrom may be restricted in order to avoid danger to persons or other traffic using the road and/or for preventing the likelihood of any such danger arising.
