Lyne Crossing Road (C127) Lyne
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022

On 20 April 2022 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Lyne Crossing Road (C127) Lyne as extends from its junction with (D3000) Lyne Crossing Road to its junction with the access to the property known as "Lyne Hill Farm".

Alternative Route – Lyne Crossing Road; Almnors Road; Lyne Lane; and Lyne Crossing Road or this same route in reverse.

The Order is required to facilitate telecoms pole replacement and/or cabling and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of BT Openreach within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 1 day between the hours of 9.30am and 3.30pm within the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Traffic Order which commences on 26 April 2022.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road including access by emergency vehicles to these properties will be maintained via operatives on site as and when required, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists.
