Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Hare Lane (C158) Claygate which extends from its junction with (D6831) Station Road to its junction with (D6829) Ashton Road. Alternative Route – Milbourne Lane, (A244) Claremont Lane, (A307) Portsmouth Road, (A309) Kingston By-pass, Manor Road South, Oaken Lane and Hare Lane or this route in reverse. The Order is required to facilitate bridge repair works and/or utility maintenance works to be carried out by, or on behalf of Network Rail within the length of road described in this notice. These works are anticipated to be carried out over 8 weeks within the 18-month period of operation of the Temporary Order that commences on 01 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times. Access for residents, the emergency services and all other traffic will be via the signed diversion route.
