Queen Mary Avenue (D3424) Camberley and Vale Road (D3426) Camberley
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 31 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of a) Queen Mary Avenue (D324) Camberley to its junction with Vale Road (D3426) Camberley to a point in line with the common boundary between No.17 and No.15 Queen Mary Avenue and; b) that length of Vale Road (D3426) Camberley at its junction with Queen Mary Avenue (D3424) for a distance of 20 metres either side. Alternative Route- a) Queen Mary Avenue, Vale Road, Victoria Avenue and Queen Mary Avenue and; b) Vale Road, Doman Road, Glebeland Road, Stanhope Road and Queen Mary Avenue. This Order is required to facilitate gas mains replacement works by or on behalf of SGN. These works are anticipated to be completed within 4 weeks, between the hours of 7am and 7pm during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 20 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in operation 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
