**D5352 Nutshell Lane, Farnham**  
**Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023**

On 08 February 2023 Surrey County Council made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of D5352 Nutshell Lane, Farnham that extends from the south-western property boundary of “No.1 Bishop Sumner Drive”, to its junction with A3016 Upper Hale Road.

This Traffic Order is required to enable BT Openreach to access overhead structures to make a new customer connection and/or to carry out cabling and/or ducting and/or maintenance works in the length of D5352 Nutshell Lane, Farnham that extends outside “Manor House Cottage”. These works are anticipated to be carried out between the hours of 8am and 4pm, within 1 day of the 12-month period of operation of this Temporary Order that commences on 14 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed, and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed.

Access for emergency vehicles, residents, businesses, pedestrians, cyclists, and equestrians will be maintained at all times.

Alternative route: - Nutshell Lane, The Green and Upper Hale Road.
