

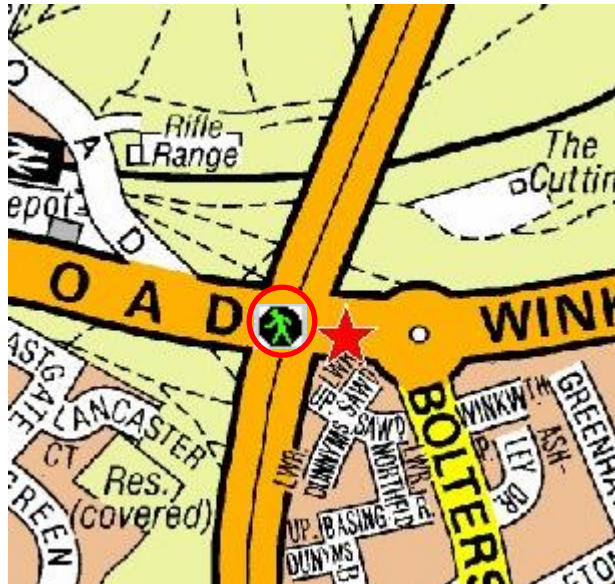

## Update to what are we going to do?

We will be replacing and improving the traffic lights and pedestrian crossing at the Banstead Crossing, A217 Brighton Road at the junction with Bolters Lane, Banstead.

## Information for residents and businesses.

We will be replacing all the traffic light equipment as it has become obsolete and is in poor condition. We will also be improving the pedestrian facilities.

The location of the work is highlighted on the map on this leaflet.

- Temporary signals will be in place for 24 hours a day during the works.
- On 5 August for one day the left turn into Fir Tree Road will be closed for cabling work.
- The northbound right turn from the A217 into Bolters Lane will be closed for the duration of the scheme.
- The southbound right turn from the A217 into Fir Tree Road will be closed for the duration of the scheme.
- There will be a right turn ban in and out of Burgh Wood during these works.

### Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather or failure of our existing pipework. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

### Noise

There will be some noise but we will try to keep this to a minimum.
