

## What are we going to do?

- We will be continuing our work on South Street where we will be renewing the opposite side of the footways and kerbing as well as improving the road layout and providing another new loading bay.
- We will be working at the Playhouse junction (between South Street and Ashley Avenue) and Marquis junction (between South Street and High Street), improving the junction layout and traffic signals ahead of converting South Street into a 2-way street.
- This project will change the road layout in Epsom to help reduce congestion and improve the town centre's appearance.

## Information for residents and businesses

Traffic management will be permanently in place for the majority of the works. This will include temporary traffic signals at the Epsom Playhouse junction and the Marquis junctions on South Street.

We know that traffic flow through Epsom is critical, and even a minor incident can create major disruption. We are planning the works carefully with our contractor and SCC's Traffic Signals team will monitor and adjust traffic signals to try and minimise impacts, if safe to do so.

Some evening work may take place if and when required between 18.00 and 06.00. Appropriate notification will be provided.

We will make sure you can get to and from your house or business when it is safe to do so. Please talk to a member of our staff on site if you need help – talking to our staff can solve most issues.

We apologise for any delays this work causes and thank you for your cooperation and patience but **please plan for longer travel times.**

### Delays in work

Our work is sometimes delayed by bad weather. We will keep you updated on any changes via the advance warning signs.

### Parking

It is essential to keep the road free from parked vehicles. Access to the Ashley Centre Car Park will be maintained at all times.

### Noise

There will be some noise but we will try to keep this to a minimum.
