Send Hill (D232) Send
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) and 14(7) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to (a) prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Send Hill (D232) Send. Alternative Route- Send Hill, (A247) Send Barnes Lane, (B2215) London Road, Woodhill, Vicarage Lane and Send Hill or this route in reverse; and (b) suspend "The Surrey County Council D232 Send Hill Send Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2022" in its entirety. This Order is required to carry out new water connection works by or on behalf of Affinity Water. These works are anticipated to be completed within 7 days, between 8am and 6pm during the 12 month period of operation of this Order which will commence on 01 February 2023. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure and suspension, which are anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described above.
