Kingston Road (Service Road 332 – 380) (D2414) Ewell
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2021

On 07 July 2021 Surrey County Council Made the above-mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to temporarily prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Kingston Road (Service Road 332 – 380) (D2414) Ewell as extends from its junction with (D2372) Salisbury Road to its junction with (D2414) Timbercroft. The alternative route will be via Salisbury Road; and Kingston Road.

This Order, which will commence on 21 July 2021 for a period of 18 months is required because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near the said roads, to be carried out by or on behalf of Surrey County Council, including but not limited to: carriageway surfacing and/or major highway maintenance works.

Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure, which is anticipated to be in force 24 hours per day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times, as will access for emergency service vehicles in an emergency situation only. Vehicular access for residents and businesses will be maintained only when safe to do so, if necessary, via the diversion route. During certain phases of the works, vehicular access to premises may be restricted, when this is the case such restriction of access will apply for no more than eight hours within any 24-hour period.
