Village Street (C59) Newdigate
Temporary Prohibition of Traffic Order 2023

On 25 January 2023 Surrey County Council made the above mentioned Temporary Traffic Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in that length of Village Street (C59) Newdigate which extends from its southern junction with (D301) Henfold Lane to a point 12 metres south of its junction with (D302) Church Lane. This Order, which will commence on 30 January 2023 for a period of 18 months is required to facilitate carriageway re-surfacing works to be completed by or on behalf of Surrey County Council. These works are anticipated to be completed over a period of approximately 5 days between the hours of 7am and 5pm. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access to premises within the affected length of road, including access by emergency service vehicles to these properties, will be maintained at all times, as will access for pedestrians and cyclists. All other traffic will be required to follow the alternative route described below. **Alternative Route-** Rusper Road, Partridge Lane and Parkgate Road or this route in reverse
